Nowadays, you will find the five-star superior hotel La Butte aux Bois right on the edge of National Park Hoge Kempen. Located in the middle of nature, the lush and leafy estate covers 12 hectares and offers a special habitat to wild boars and deer. The neighbouring park is home to robins, wild ducks, geese and various birds of prey.


"WUNDERKAMMER" PRIVATE DINING

Our resort offers a world-class experience. The private dining area acts as the connector between our fine dining restaurant Ralf Berendsen and our bistrôt Le Ciel.



Contemporary-style accommodation in a quiet location with lake and forest views.


The Villa offers 16 rooms and is located in the hotel's grounds within 100m of the Manoir, accessed via a covered pergola.






LA FORÊT






THE MANOIR
